Over the past two years, six local First Nations groups – the Wulgurukaba Walkabouts, Big Eye Theatre Dancers, Komet Dancers, Obery Sambo, Meriam Dancers, and Bindal Dancers – have come together for the first time in decades to connect, collaborate and co-create a new performance work alongside Dancenorth Australia.

Journey into the Dreaming in a ground-breaking celebration of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander music, song, dance, and storytelling.
