Townsville Sailing Club. Location and Access

The Townsville Sailing Club is located at 3 Mariners Drive Townsville (next to the marina).

At the Eastern end of Townsville's iconic Strand.

SABOT drop off will be via the driveway entry to the left of Club House.

There will be a fenced off area, turn to the left after unloading and exit back onto Mariners Drive.

Space is extremely limited so it would be appreciated if this area could be vacated as quickly as possible. (your cooperation in this would be greatly appreciated).



Alternatively find a space along the Strand and unload and walk boat in.

Sabot collection at the end of the regatta will be the same procedure.

Pre & Post Regatta "loaded" trailer parking is available if you arrive before or wish to stay a little longer.

Registration and Measurement

Measurement will commence on Thursday 1st July 2021. All **Nationals Fleet** boats must complete ALL Measurement items and Safety Checks steps.

Sabot Week boats only need to complete a Safety Check.

Measurement stations and Safety Check are the first steps in the Measurement process for Your boat.

There will be 4 stations for Measurement/ Safety, and they may be completed in any order.

 Hull - weight and foil measurement. 	(Ground floor of Club House)	
• Sail.	(2 nd Floor of club house)	
Masts and Boom.	(club house grounds)	
• Safety Check.	(Club House grounds)	

The final step is Registration.

Once the measurement process is completed, take your completed measurement forms to

the 2nd floor of the Club House with a copy of your Certificate of Currency of 3rd Party Insurance.

(You can take a photo of your insurance paperwork on your phone).

This will assist the registration process and be aware that the Race Committee may ask to sight your Insurance.

A parental risk warning and indemnity form will be required to be signed on behalf of all children.

This process may take a short time so please be patient while we comply with the class rules.

Rigging and Storage Area

Our rigging area is directly out the front of the Townsville Sailing club on a large flat lawn area with views you will not believe.

Boats will be stored in same area with overnight security engaged.

Competitors Briefing and Daily Awards

At the conclusion of racing at the end of each day (except the final day) there will be a short prize giving and awards.

We will also have some hot food on offer at our club house.

With a sausage sizzle which will be **free** of charge for competitors & available for purchase for family members.

Placings & encouragement awards will be awarded daily.

Sign On/ Off

All Sabot Skippers must personally SIGN ON and SIGN OFF on the sheets provided located. At the TSC Club House

Presentation dinner

Will be a low-key finger food event with live entertainment at the Townsville Sailing Club after presentation. Tickets at \$30.00 per person can be purchased through registration page.

Viewing areas

Anywhere along the strand will be a good opportunity to park up under a palm tree and watch. Strand Park or from the Pier will be the best location. (wind dependent).

Spectator Vessels

We will have spectator vessels available.

If you fancy some time on the water to have a different view.

Support Boats

Boat Ramp

The nearest launching point is the city Boat Ramp. Located on Sir Leslie Thiess Drive It is an excellent facility with 2 floating wharfs.

Over Night

We have arranged some Berths in the Breakwater Marina. 2min walk to Clubhouse.

Certain Race Management vessels will have priority.

All storage is at the owner's risk.

Refueling.

Fuel is available at Breakwater Marinas Fuel wharf with c/card pumps.

Race Management vessels will have priority.

Private Support Boat Identification.

A support boat flag will be issued from the registration desk.

A \$20 bond is required and is refundable once the flag has been returned at the end of the regatta.


Trailer Storage

The club has arranged trailer storage in Wilson Parking Lot which is a short distance from the club.

Storage of Trailers and contents are at the owner's risk.

Trailer storage will be available only for registered competitors/ support boats.

We would still suggest you bring a lock for your trailer.
